

## COOKIE POLICY

*This is the version translated automatically. In the event of any doubts as to the interpretation, the Polish language version shall prevail.*

1. The website does not automatically collect any information, except for information contained in cookies.
2. Cookies (the so-called "cookies") are IT data, in particular text files, which are stored in the User's terminal device and are intended to use the website of the Service. Cookies usually contain the name of the website they come from, the length of time they are stored on the terminal equipment and a unique number.
3. The entity that places cookies on the User's terminal device and gains access to them is the Administrator of the Service.
4. Cookies are used for the purpose:
  - a) adjust the content of the Website to the User's preferences and optimize the use of the Website; in particular, these files allow the User's device to be recognized and the Website to be displayed appropriately, adapted to his or her individual needs;
  - b) create statistics that help us understand how users use our websites to improve their structure and content;
  - c) maintenance of the User session.
5. The following types of cookies are used in the Service:
  - a) "session" (session cookies) and 'permanent' cookies (persistent cookies). Session cookies are temporary files that are stored in the User's terminal equipment until the User logs out, leaves the website or switches off the software (web browser). "Permanent" cookies are stored in the User's terminal device for a period of time specified in the parameters of cookies or until they are deleted by the User;
  - b) "necessary" cookie files, enabling the use of services available within the Service, e.g. authenticating cookie files used for services requiring authentication within the Service;
  - c) cookies used to ensure security, e.g. used to detect abuse in the scope of authentication within the Service;
  - d) "performance" cookies, enabling the collection of information on the use of the website of the Service;
  - e) "Functional" cookies, which enable "remembering" the settings selected by the User and personalisation of the User's interface, e.g. in the scope of a selected language or region from which the User originates, font size, appearance of the website, etc., in order to enable the User to "remember" the settings selected by the User and to personalize the User's interface, e.g. in the scope of a selected language or region from which the User originates, font size, appearance of the website, etc;
  - f) "advertising" cookies, enabling the provision to Users of advertising content more adapted to their interests.
6. In many cases, the web browsing software (web browser) by default allows cookies to be stored in the User's terminal device. Users can change the settings for cookies at any time. These settings may be changed in particular in such a way as to block the automatic handling of cookies in the settings of the Internet browser or inform about each time they are placed in the User's device. Detailed information on the possibilities and methods of handling cookies are available in the settings of the software (web browser).
7. The Administrator informs that restrictions on the use of cookies may affect some of the functionalities available on the Website.
